Sub: Corrective action/s to prevent Vector-borne disease within the area under your jurisdiction as per Memo No. HIB/M/6-D08-16/660 dated 02.03.2017.

Ref: Report of 4th Meeting of Core Group on prevention and management of Dengue at Nabanna dated 14.8.2019.

Instructions have been issued vide this office letter bearing No. ED-1391 /2017 dated 23.03.2017, ED-1772/2017 dt.24.5.2018, ED- 1933 / 2017 dt.31.8.2017, ED-1861/ 2017 dated 06.07.2017 and ED-587 / 2018 dated 22.03.2018 and Memo No: ED- 827 / 2018 dated 14th September, 2018 and ED- 516 / 2019 dated 13th March, 2019 regarding cleanliness of the premises of educational institutions to prevent Vector Borne diseases. All Principals/Teachers-in-Charge/Officer-in-Charge of Govt., Govt. aided and erstwhile Sponsored colleges were requested to take necessary measures for prevention & control of Vector-borne diseases. However, it has been informed that maximum numbers of Dengue cases have been reported in the following areas:

1. **North 24 Parganas** – Habra , Ashoknagar, Bongaon, Barrackpore , Panihati , Titagarh, Bhatpara Municipalities,Habra I , Habra II, Gaighata, Bongaon and Barrackpore II Block.
2. **South 24 Parganas**- Maheshtala, Rajpur Sonarpur Municipalities, Bishnupur II. Bhangore II, Budge Budge II, Kakdwip blocks
3. **Alipurduar** – Kalchini Block.
4. **Nadia**- Haringhata, Hanskhali, Nabadwip, Krishnagar I, Chakdaha blocks
5. **Darjeeling**- Siliguri MC.
6. **Murshidabad**- Farakka, Samsherganj, Beldanga II, Berhampore, Nawada Blocks
7. **Jalpaiguri**- Damdim more , Mal, Meteli Block
8. **Uttar Dinajpur**- Raigunj Municipality, Raigunj block

Under the circumstances, all the Head of the Institutions situated within the focus areas mentioned above are directed to take corrective action/s to resolve the vectorogenic situation and to take necessary arrangement for prevention & control of Vector-borne disease and general awareness programme among the students regarding preventive measures as per guidelines set forth by the Directorate of Health Service, Govt. of West Bengal under the aforesaid memo mentioned.

This may be treated as extremely urgent.
